THE PROJECT

Kids Rock! is partnering with the City of Luverne to create a licensed child care center at 1 Roundwind Road in Luverne that will provide care for

the new center will:

Accommodate care for 24 infants, 42 toddlers, 60 preschoolers, and 60 school age children.

Include 11 classrooms, a gym, a commercial kitchen, office and staff support spaces, a conference room, restrooms, nursing rooms, laundry and storage rooms, and outdoor playgrounds.

Feature safety, security, and technology improvements, an improved parking lot for efficient drop-off and pick-up, new plumbing and HVAC throughout the facility, and a new roof.

Meet all indoor and outdoor space needs as required by the Minnesota Department of Human Services.
